2019 NOTICE OF RACE SAILING PROGRAMME

Number 2019 / 04 – Start Sequence

INTRODUCTION

The GP14 Fleet is trialling a new start sequence on Mondays for the Spring Dinghy Series to make fleet racing more interesting during the race. No change to Race Management or start signals is required, but Race Teams should be aware that the GP14 start may look strange. The GP14 Fleet is split into Gold, Silver and Bronze (see noticeboard). Bronze Fleet boats will start with the normal class start signal (i.e. when the first red light on the race hut goes out, with one sound); Silver Fleet boats will start one minute after that (which coincides with the Preparatory signal for the following fleet - YW Dayboats); Gold Fleet will start 1 minute later (2 minutes after the Fleet official start and 3 minutes before the Dayboat start. Race Officers shall signal any Bronze Fleet OCS in the normal way, but should ignore the Silver and Bronze Fleet boats which will self-police their later starts.

GP14 Class Captain will advise the Dayboat Fleet that there may be late starting GP14s near the start line during the YWDB preparatory period. Normal Racing Rules of Sailing will determine rights of way between boats.
